

Fuji Electric E&C Group Green Procurement Guidelines

I. Fuji Electric E&C Group Green Procurement Policy

As we work toward a sustainable society with low environmental impact, where possible we make every effort to choose environmentally friendly products in our purchasing activities. In our procurement activities, we focus on the following environmental conservation activities.

- (1) Promotion of energy and resource efficiency (2) Reduction of CO₂ emissions
- (3) Prevention of waste generation (4) Promotion of recycling

II. Selection of Priority Items

1. We select priority items from the construction materials and equipment category that are subject to proactive procurement.
2. Based on the procurement and construction departments' procurement records, designated procurement items under the Act on Promotion of Procurement of Eco-Friendly Goods and Services by the State and Other Entities (Green Procurement Act), and Eco Mark products, we select priority items in line with the following.
 - (1) Items that contribute to lower environmental impact (2) Items procured in large amounts
 - (3) Items that contribute significantly to lower environmental impact, even if procured in small amounts
3. Ascertaining Procurement Records
 - (1) For the construction materials and equipment category, we look at the procurement records (price and amount) of four items.
 - (2) These items are LED lighting, transformers, air conditioners, and eco-cables.
4. Promotion System
 - (1) The Procurement & Supply Headquarters is responsible for reviewing and examining this procurement policy, priority items, and aggregation methods, etc.
 - (2) The Procurement & Supply Headquarters collaborates and makes adjustments with relevant departments from each branch in the company-wide rollout of this operation.
5. Operation Policy
 - (1) When reviewing and examining priority items, we make decisions based on revisions and additions to designated procurement items and judgment criteria under the Green Procurement Act, future technological developments, and customer requirements, for example.
 - (2) By disclosing information on the Fuji Electric E&C Group's green procurement initiatives based on these guidelines through our website, etc., we will seek to promote understanding of green procurement activities among our clients and business partners.
